They will be camping, cooking, cleaning and working on scout skills as patrols. The first year scouts will be working on requirements for the Tenderfoot and the second year scouts will be working on the final requirements for First Class. The Venture Crew will be camping at different location within Webb Mountain Park. The troop will also be performing a service project at Webb Mtn.

In the weeks leading up to this campout, the patrols will be preparing their meals and duty rosters. The patrols will be responsible for the planning and the purchase of the required food and supplies for the weekend. More information will follow (including a list of things to bring).

The troop will be hiking into our campsite from the main parking lot. Scouts will be required to carry in their personal supplies on their back. A backpack will be required.

As with all of our outings, the following will NOT be permitted on this trip:

Candy (mini-bear bait)

Cell phones (leaders will have cell phones for emergencies)

Radios, iPods or any other electronic devices

Note: If a scout brings a cell phone or an electronic device, they will be confiscated for the duration and returned when we arrive back in Shelton. We ask that all scouts and parents obey these rules

For this campout, we are limiting the adult leaders to the Scoutmasters and patrol advisors. This campout will be used to allow the first year scouts to learn to camp with their patrols.
